EFFECTIVE: 1601HRS, NOVEMBER 15, 2010

ITEM 1 - CONSTRUCTIVE CODE 97 WILL BE ELIMINATED DECEMBER 1, 2010

- A. EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2010, CONSTRUCTIVE CODE 97 WILL BE ELIMINATED AND NO LONGER A VALID CONSTRUCTIVE CODE IN WHICH TO FILE CLAIMS.
- B. THE FOLLOWING CODES HAVE BEEN CREATED TO CATEGORIZE SIMILAR CLAIMS WHICH WERE BEING FILED UNDER CC97. PLEASE BEGIN USING THESE CODES IN PLACE OF CODE 97.

CODE AS - ASSIGNMENT ADVERTISEMENT ISSUES. ISSUES INVOLVING ADVERTISEMENT OF ASSIGNMENTS - INCORRECT LIMITS, MILEAGE, ETC.

CODE CA - CREW IMPROPERLY USED. ISSUES INVOLVING RUNAROUNDS, NOT USED IN PROPER SERVICE, ETC.

CODE KS - KIND OF SERVICE ISSUES. PAY SHORTAGES RESULTING FROM INCORRECT KIND OF SERVICE, MILEAGE, ETC.

CODE RM - ROAD SWITCHER/MINE RUN ISSUES. RULE VIOLATIONS FOR ROADSWITCHERS AND MINE RUNS.

CODE RW - RETURN TO WORK ISSUES. RETURN FROM FURLOUGH, MEDICAL LEAVE, FMLA, ETC.

CODE SI - SENIORITY ISSUES. ALL ISSUES INVOLVING SENIORITY.

CODE YW - YARD WORK IN ROAD SERVICE. YARD WORK PERFORMED BY ROAD CREWS AND WORK PERFORMED AT INITIAL, INTERMEDIATE AND FINAL TERMINALS.
